### KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN CAUTION

#### FIRST AID

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

TRANSFIX is a excellent sticking agent intended for use with most crop protection products in which the label permits the use of a spreader sticker. TRANSFIX is compatible in spray solutions with most commercial crop protection and foliar feed micronutrients. A thin coating of TRANSFIX solution bonds the pesticide to the crop foliage. This decreases the risk of residue erosion from rainfall or irrigation.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

##### For Terrestrial Use Only – Not For Aquatic Use

Add TRANSFIX to the spray tank as it is filling, with the agitator running. Performance is dependent upon environmental conditions. Transfix should be applied at least one hour before an expected rainfall. Sunlight during this time frame is also necessary for better adherence of the bond.
