General Information

Prevent turf loss, reduce watering requirements, and maintain turf quality through regular use of PROFORMA BLUE LABEL Turf & Soil Penetrant. PROFORMA BLUE LABEL is formulated to reduce the effects of localized dry spot caused by hard-to-wet soil conditions typically found in soils with high sand content. University testing confirms that PROFORMA BLUE LABEL will enhance soil moisture content thereby reducing watering requirements and maintain turf quality.

Use Directions

Golf Course Greens & Tees:

As a preventative treatment for localized dry spot with extended residual activity:

Apply an initial application of PROFORMA BLUE LABEL early in the season after irrigation has begun. Apply 8 fl. ounces of PROFORMA BLUE LABEL per 1,000 sq. of turf area in 1 to 3 gallons of water. Repeat application 7 to 14 days as a follow up treatment.

As a localized dry spot curative treatment:

Follow up monthly applications of PROFORMA BLUE LABEL are recommended throughout the season. Apply 4 fl. ounces of PROFORMA BLUE LABEL per 1,000 sq. ft. of turf area in 1 to 3 gallons of water.

Following any soil penetrant applications, a light watering of treated turf areas is recommended to reduce concentration on the leaf surface and promote infiltration into the soil.

Prior to use, always be sure that spray tank and equipment lines are thoroughly cleaned and free of any contaminants. Conduct compatibility and turf safety tests prior to mixing this or any penetrant and other plant protectants or fertilizers. Soil penetrants can enhance the efficacy of other tank mix active ingredients and possibly release sediment or active ingredients remaining in spray tank or spray lines.

Golf Course Fairways, Sod Farms, Recreational, Commercial, and Sports Turfgrass Areas:

Apply PROFORMA BLUE LABEL mid to late spring or well in advance of the high heat stress period by diluting 2.5-gallons of PROFORMA BLUE LABEL to every 50 gallons of water and apply to every acre of turfgrass. Re-apply as conditions require.

Recommendations for Use in Wisconsin:

For applications involving use of this product within the State of Wisconsin, PROFORMA BLUE LABEL is recommended for use on turfgrass grown on sand-based constructed soils such as those found on golf courses and athletic fields.

Lawn Care:

Dilute in 5 to 10 gallons of water. Apply 4 to 6 fl.oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. Repeat applications as moisture or temperature conditions require.

Injection into Irrigation Systems:

Apply 1 to 4 qts. per acre. Repeat injections as needed. Supplemental treatment of tees and greens may be required.

Trees, Shrubs, and Flowerbeds:

Dilute in 5 to 10 gallons of water. Apply 4 to 8 fl. oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply every 7 to 14 days to aid water penetration. Irrigate immediately following application.

Precautionary Statements

Caution: May cause eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Applicators should wear goggles or a facial splash shield and chemical-resistant gloves. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
